- -Pool Salt/Chlorine Systems chlorine systems cannot keep up with all the chlorine because NYS does not allow cyanuric acid in public pools, so chlorine is evaporating more quickly and the existing salt cells are at max output. Salt cells have to be replaced approximately every 3-5 years. Consider switching back to chlorine pools due to cost of salt and chlorine. Will look at longterm costs and provide to board.
- -Need assessment on Greenwood clubhouse electrical.
- -Eveningwood Pool lights are not working for nighttime parties.
- -Tree removal on Primrose and Dodge. Management confirming whether or not trees are on Association land. May need survey.
- -Discussing contract with All Seasons for landscaping within RO.
