Assessment Payment

There are three ways to pay your assessment:

- 1. Pay online the second page behind your invoice is instructions for creating an account for on-line payment. You must have your invoice which specifies your account number to complete the transaction.
- 2. Mail in you can send in a check with top portion of your statement that reflects your name, address, and most important, your account number. Check should be made out to Ransom Oaks Community Corporation, and mailed to 101 Ransom Oaks Drive, East Amherst, NY 14051.
- 3. Pay In-person Management company will be present at Ransom Oaks Clubhouse at times specified below. Here you can make payment, provide the required resident data and pick up your resident passes at Ransom Oaks clubhouse: January 7, 8, 24, 28, and 31st from 1-3pm and 6-9pm. February 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, 25, 26, 27, and 28th from 12-3pm and 7-9pm.

Management Update

Plans are underway for summer programming and improvements in Ransom Oaks. The most exciting change is the conversion of all 6 pools to salt water systems. There is a significant long-term cost savings for the community. Estimates come



close to \$10,000 annual savings in chemicals. Current system uses bromine, which is expensive and can be caustic to your skin, causing red eyes and itchy skin. Salt water pools are only about 1/10th the salinity of ocean water, but enough to sanitize and give the water a "softer" feel.

There are a number of questions and comments coming back to management and Board members. We are working hard to address all questions and hope that you will share your ideas as well. One question regarding the budget reminds me to let everyone know that this was a preliminary budget and the final budget will be available before the annual meeting in April. Quotes and final assessments of what can be completed in 2019, are still under discussion.

More than one resident has asked that we mention sidewalk safety and keeping your sidewalks shoveled. A few years ago, the Town of Amherst passed a resolution to increase the fines for sidewalks not shoveled within 24 hours. This is just a reminder to keep them clear. Thank you.

There have been a number of calls and emails requesting assistance with the online payment program. It is very exciting that so many are using this option. Don't forget that you can still pay the traditional way and you can make payment in person. See last months issue of the newsletter for office hours at Ransom Oaks club house throughout the month of February. We are requesting household information prior to release of resident pool tags. There will be additional Spring office hours set up for the next newsletter and posted to FaceBook and website for residents to pick up pool tags.

Keep warm and stay safe this winter.


