Residents must check in at Dispatch before dropping off electronics. These items include but are not limited to: DVD/VCR's; Stereo equipment including speakers, receivers and record players; computers & printers; telephones & answering machines; chargers & radios of all types; copy machines; microwaves

Buybackmadness.com will buy your old CD's, DVD and video games and they even pay shipping if you send more than 15 items.

Vanocur Refractories will recycle your large Styrofoam pieces from packing. They are located at 3937-4001 River Road, in Tonawanda. UPS will recycle Styrofoam packing peanuts.

# **Ransom Oaks Pool Safety Code and Conditions of Use**

- All staff are responsible for ensuring that all people using the facilities abide by the rules and regulations of the pool. Any
  behavior that could be or is detrimental to the safety and well being of patrons of the pool will be stopped immediately.
  Guards will issue one warning. If a second consult for inappropriate behavior must be addressed with same individual,
  they will be uninvited from the pool for the day.
- Entrance and use of pool is restricted to residents and their guests. Pool tags must be shown and any guests must be accompanied by a resident with their pool tags and guest pass.
- Prohibited acts include, but are not limited to: running, throwing keys or projectiles, gymnastics, excessive screaming or shouting, and offensive language.
- Prohibited items at the pool include, but are not limited to: large floatation devices, snorkels and fins, glass containers, food and chewing gum.
- Residents and/or guests of residents under the influence of alcohol or drugs are restricted from the pool and will not be granted access.
- All children under 12 years of age will be accompanied and supervised by a parent or responsible adult or sitter.
- Babies and non-potty trained toddlers must wear suitable swim diapers
- All non-swimmers are restricted to the shallow end of the pool until they can pass a swim test issued and approved by lifeguard on duty.
- Swimmers are prohibited from hanging on or swimming over the pool boom.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted anywhere in the pool area or immediate surround.
- Ransom Oaks management and employees reserve the right to refuse entry or prohibit use of facilities for violating any rules of conduct.

# **April Architectural EMA Q&A Corner**

**Q:** Who is responsible for removing my leaves and twigs during spring clean up?

**A:** According to the TOA, you may place your *paper bags* of leaves and bundled twigs with your garbage totes on our pick up day (Thursday). Please be fair in the number of yard debris bags that you add to your garbage collection weekly. Please do not put yard debris in plastic bags.



**Q:** I have a yard service clean my yard can I put their debris with my garbage on our pick up day?

**A:** Technically no, if you employ a lawn or gardening service, they are responsible for removal of all debris and yard waste gathered on your property during their visit. It is their responsibility to dispose of all waste collected.

Starting May 20th, the TOA Highway department will scour neighborhoods for large debris piles to be removed. It has been suggested that you do not haul your lawn debris to the center of cul-de-sacs or your driveways, etc. before this pick up date.
