## **Management Update**

This past month the playgrounds at Greenwood and Ransom Oaks were completed, Greenwood Clubhouse interior was painted, and a variety of repairs were made. Currently, we are overseeing several drainage and electrical projects.



Old growth trees are one of the things that many of our residents loved when selecting this neighborhood to live in. The development of this community was designed to maintain the old growth trees and add new plantings to create a park-like setting. Over the years Ransom Oaks has lost hundreds of trees to fungus, disease and invasive species. This year was an aggressive year to remove these and the Board of Directors has taken note. They understand the responsibility to maintain Ransom Oaks for the long term and are actively investigating what can be done to ensure the neighborhood has beautiful trees in the future.

Soon we will all be raking leaves and shortly after that shoveling snow. Please understand that it is a legal requirement to maintain sidewalks on your property, as noted in the applicable copy of Town of Amherst code below, regarding owner responsibilities. In addition to keeping the sidewalk clear, we also must remember that the roads cannot be filled with leaves, snow or debris. When preparing your yard for leaf pickup, please pile adjacent to the road, such that leaves do not clog drains or interfere with driver right of way.

- □ § 83-9-5 Owner responsibility.
- 5-1. Owner to maintain sidewalk; exceptions.
  - 5-1.1. The owner or occupant of any premises fronting or abutting on any street or highway shall repair, keep safe and maintain any sidewalk abutting the premises and keep it free and clear from snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction. All trees, shrubs, plants and other vegetation must be cut back to a height of eight feet directly above the surface of any sidewalk. Any such owner or occupant shall be liable for any injury or damage by reason of omission or failure to repair, keep safe and maintain such sidewalk or to remove snow, ice or other obstructions therefrom or negligence in performing those functions.<sup>[1]</sup>
    - [1] Editor's Note: Former Subsections 5-1.2, 5-1.3, 5-1.4, 5-1.5, added 4-11-2011 by L.L. No. 7-2011, and 5-1.6, added 4-11-2011 by L.L. No. 6-2011, amended 6-6-2011 by L.L. No. 16-2011, which provided exemptions to certain property owners from the requirement to keep sidewalks that are located along rear property lines adjacent to certain major highways free from snow and ice, were repealed 5-21-2012 by L.L. No. 10-2012.
- **5-2.** No person shall plow, shovel, sweep or pile snow, ice or other materials in or beyond the right-of-way of any street or public highway or cause such to be done so as to interfere with the safety and convenience of public travel.

As we approach the end the year, the Board of Directors has a busy agenda. In addition to the year-end project prioritization and budget preparations for 2020, they are also preparing to choose a new management company. We appreciate all of their support and work this past two years. Thank you.

Each pole has a rectangular sticker on it, usually on the sidewalk side. Please tell us the street and the pole number and your visual inspection findings.

We have documented a few with openings at the base, exposed wires, and "temporary" metal wraps poorly secured to the base of the pole. If a light is also not working, let us know that too!
