Board of Directors Meeting Highlights

February 9, 2015

- Four residents attended the meeting:
 - The Town of Amherst is proposing to ban parking along a 600 foot section of Greenwoods Drive where users of the pool, playground, and tennis courts now park.
 - During this meeting we heard that the Town Approved the parking ban.
- About \$74,000 in assessments have been paid so far.
- February 28, 2015 is the last day to pay assessments without a penalty. Online payments will stop February 28 at midnight.
- We installed additional security on our website because one or more persons are attempting to hack into it.
- Regarding policies for 2015
- No changes to **guest policy**
- No changes to swimming age and swim tests
- No changes to pool hours

- No changes to party hours
- No changes to costs for a party
- We will have a pool cleaning person for 15/20 hours a week during the season.
- Projects approved for 2015
 - Remodel Ransom Oaks Meeting Room
 - Reseal Eveningwood drive and parking lot
 - Resurface tennis courts at Ransom Oaks
 - Replace Greenwood and Eveningwood water heaters
- We will receive an award from the Community Association Institute
- We are looking into upgrading the security systems at the pools.


