## Facilities Report

RANSOM OAKS

By the time that you read this we will be within a few weeks of opening the pools for

the season. Back in November we held a focus meeting at the Ransom Oaks building with Jim Golding (Treasurer/ Facilities Board Member), Kathy Halter (Facilities Manager), Tom Halter (Facilities Manager) and several residents. I would like to review some of the suggestions that came out of that meeting.

The residents brought to our attention that many residents were unaware that **eating and drinking in the pool area is prohibited** by Ransom Oaks and the New York State Health Code also prohibits it. We will try to do a better job informing residents and guests that you must leave food and drinks outside the pool area or on the porch at Eveningwood. We will be asking the lifeguards to also refrain from eating while on duty.

Another issue that came up was that residents were not asked or did not **show tags on each visit to the pool**. We ask that you help us by always bringing a pool tag for each family member and your guest pass when bring any guests. Ransom Oaks does not allow lending pool tags to anyone, you could lose your pool privileges if you are caught. Ransom Oaks will also be stepping up the sign in and tag checking this coming season.

We will be trying a lap swim on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM at the Greenwood pool. We will be adding additional lifeguard hours at the Greenwood pool this season. Insisting that lifeguards are NOT allowed to sit together when swimmers are in the pool. And toys will be limited to the wading pools only. On windy days we will ask for your help in not raising the umbrella's and will have signs on those days at the sign-in table.

The residents should **sign up for email notices** on the www.ransomoaks. com website for pool closing notices and summer activities. We will also post notices on the white boards at the pools.

New this season. We have **painted all the fencing at Greenwood** and **remodeled the Ransom Oaks community building** since the pools closed last fall. We are currently under contract to resurface the Greenwood pools and install steps in the wading pools at Eveningwood and Greenwood before the season starts.

Finally, **Pickleball is coming to Ransom Oaks** this season. We will be lining a tennis court to accommodate both tennis and Pickleball.

We look forward to a safe and enjoyable season!

## **Board Meeting** Highlights

March 14, 2016

- One resident attended the meeting.
- Erie County Water Authority has a plan that will have them supply water to refill the Greenwood pool after it is refurbished. The rate will be \$3.17/1000 gallons. The pool contains about 160,000 gallons
- Apparently the Ginger Court circle sustained some damage over the winter. The courts are the property of the Town of Amherst and the Town maintains them. In the past, residents have placed things in the court and the Town has removed them. To avoid conflicts the ROCC does not do repair work or improvements to the courts. Note, since, in the past, the Town did not mulch or mow the courts to our requirements, the ROCC has a deal with the Town that allows us to mulch and mow the courts in exchange for a quantity of mulch.
- We are about on budget.
- As of 42 days after the due date, 148 residents have not paid their assessments. If not paid, including penalties and interest, by August 1, 2016, liens will be put in place on the properties.
- Pool tags should be mailed soon. Residents that have received letters from the Architectural Committee describing conditions on their property that are not in compliance with the Covenants will not receive their tags until their property is brought into compliance.
- The auditors have received all our financial information for the 2015 audit
- We may need to hire 1 or 2 lifeguards for this season. Applications can be submitted via the RansomOaks.com website
- Tennis courts should open as soon as the weather breaks.
- The tennis court at the Ransom Oaks area will be available for either tennis or pickle ball. It will be "lined" for both. Residents can sign up for either sport for an hour of play. There will be two pickle ball courts in the space. The Ransom Oaks court was chosen because it has only one court. Apparently pickle ball can be "noisy" and could disturb tennis players on another court such as at Greenwood or Eveningwood.
- We have contracted for a pool professional to inspect the maintenance procedures and conditions of the pools. ■

### **Garage Sale Preparation**

Having a garage sale can be fun and can put some money in your pocket, but to ensure success it takes proper planning. Here are some tips for making your sale more successful:

Be clear on the purpose of your sale. Are you selling things to make money or to get rid of them? This question affects everything you do, from how you price things to how willing you are to negotiate. Surprisingly, you can often make more money (and get rid of more junk) by pricing things low. As a general rule of thumb, price items about a quarter or third of what they would cost new. There are exceptions - clothes are generally poor sellers,

**Get Cash.** Get a roll of quarters, a stack of twenty-five \$1 bills, and a few \$5 bills before the day of the sale. Also, wear an apron or fanny pack to keep

unless it's baby/kids clothes.

your money safe and your hands free. **Get Bagging Supplies.** 

**Have a calculator handy.** Make it easy for yourself to total items - price things evenly: .25, .50, and \$1, NOT .40, .75, \$1.20.

Prepare your staging area. People will be more inclined to stop if you set up shop in your yard or driveway. Some people are reluctant to enter a dark and dreary garage. Make your sale inviting and easy to browse. You can lure customers by placing highly-desirable items near the road. Ever notice how hard a woman has to work to convince a man to stop at a yard sale? To solve this, set out an old lawn mower or power tools out front in plain view of the road, and you'll get more business. It's also smart to set up a small table with nothing but "man-things" (jars full of screws and nails, electronic parts, tools and

parts of tools, etc.) This gives the men something to immerse themselves in while the women find all the real treasures.

Have an electrical outlet handy (or a long extension cord).

Be prepared as some buyers will expect you to bargain with them. If it's early in the morning and you don't want to bargain, just say "I think it's worth that price. I may lower the price later in the day if it doesn't sell.

### **Spring Brush Cleanup**

Amherst's annual spring brush pickup will begin on May 23rd. Pickup will follow the same weekly schedule as residents' refuse pickup regarding the day of the week. However it may take approximately two to three weeks for us to complete the whole Town.

Please have brush, logs and stumps out for pickup by this date. The Town will collect large unmanageable piles of logs, brush, and tree stumps only. All material must be placed out the start of that week. We are going thru all areas of the Town one time only.

No mixed piles containing lumber, concrete, railroad ties or non-organic materials will be collected. Leaves, small trimmings and other yard waste should be put in containers, paper yard waste bags or bundled for collection by Modern Corporation on a weekly basis. The Highway Department will not pick up these materials during this spring brush pickup.Questions?
