School will be out shortly, and we will be beginning another summer of activities at

the facilities. The activities that begin in June are as follows: (Please note that activities are for the residents of Ransom Oaks only.)

First session of swimming lesson begins Monday, June 27th. Please talk to guards for more information. More information will be available at any of the three pools. All lessons are held in the morning between 8:30 and 11. The cost is \$40/child.

T-Shirt Day: Tuesday, June 28th! Come and join the fun! Staff will begin at Ransom Oaks from 11:00-12:30, Eveningwood from 1:00-2:30 and Greenwood from 3:00-4:30. Watch for signs with more details at the pools.

Tennis: Courts are open and ready for you and your friends. The Ransom Oaks court now is ready for Pickleball.

This is just the beginning of things that will be going on. Visit the pools for more information as well as postings of things happening around the community. It promises to be a fun summer as usual!

We would like to welcome all the guards back for another season. This year, there is some switching, but many of the same faces! Please give all our lifeguards a fair chance. We are very lucky to have a dedicated staff!

Lifeguards have been instructed to ask all residents for pool tags and instruct residents to print their names and addresses clearly for safety purposes. Please keep your tags in your possession. Please review all pool rules before using the facilities. Please be aware that there is no eating/drinking in the pool area; this will be strictly enforced. Residents who continually break the rules will be asked to leave the area. Please do not give the guards a difficult time about this procedure. They are doing what they have been instructed to do by the Ransom Oaks Board of Directors.

Don't forget pool tags must be worn when using any of the facilities this includes the tennis courts. Guards have been instructed to ask to see tags if there are any problems.

If you have not paid your assessment fee, it will be turned over to the attorney mid-June. It is important that you contact us and make arrangements for payment. You cannot use any of the facilities until you have received pool tags.

Children "hanging" at facilities after hours, continues to be a problem. Please contact the Amherst police if you see anyone at the facilities after the posted hours of 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM. We hope you all have a safe and enjoyable summer using all of the facilities.

Dangerous Chemicals

It's finally spring time here in Buffalo; The sun is shining, the birds are chirping, and residents of Ransom Oaks and surrounding areas are looking to keep their lawns free of weeds.

What many are unaware of, however, are the toxic and long lasting effects these chemicals can have on our families. Chemical weed killers, fertilizers, and pesticides are putting our community, especially our children and pets, at risk for:

- CHILDHOOD LEUKEMIA, BRAIN CANCER, BIRTH DEFECTS, DISRUPTIONS IN THE ENDOCRINE SYSTEM
- MISCARRIAGES
- NON-HODGKINS LYMPHOMA
- LIVER AND KIDNEY DAMAGE; JUST TO NAME A FEW

Children are at higher risk due to their fragile, developing systems which causes the effects of the poisons to multiply. Several Ransom Oaks residents, including one on the board, have been told by their veterinarians that their dog's cancer was caused by lawn chemicals. The chemicals are airborne, spreading from treated to untreated lawns .Avoiding them is impossible. After being outside with our children and pets, these harmful chemicals are brought into our homes where they end up everywhere.

These poisons are also contaminating our ground water, ponds, and harming our wildlife. Even if you don't drink tap water, it's quite unsettling that we are regularly washing our dishes and clothes, not to mention bathing, in water laced with pesticides. 96% of all fish studied in major streams and rivers contain one or more pesticide.

There are over 1200 homes in Ransom Oaks, most of which use pesticides. The decision each resident makes on lawn care greatly impacts the community as a whole. Cumulatively, we are exposing our children and pets to dangerous levels of chemicals.

The only way to ensure a healthier environment for our families is for us all to say "NO" to chemical lawn care and "Yes" to all Natural Chemical-Free care.

Many areas have banned these harmful chemicals, so why are they legal here? I believe that officials are pressured by large companies and many are fooled into believing that these chemicals are safe if you follow the application guide lines. If that were true, the studies which have been done on the effects of lawn chemicals would say they are safe. They in fact say the opposite. In addition, guidelines are often not followed.

The fact that these chemicals are legal does not lessen the harmful effects they have. Unfortunately, the economic revenue from these chemicals seems to be more important than the wellbeing of the consumer. Lawn care companies and distributors of lawn chemicals, like any business, want to make money. We have the opportunity to influence how many chemicals pollute our environment by purchasing only Natural, Chemical-Free lawn care. Businesses will begin to carry even more of the Chemical-Free products.

Together we can make a difference and set an example for other communities to make the switch to natural care. It is possible to have a beautiful lawn without using harmful chemicals.

Please call your lawn care provider and switch to all natural chemical-free care or visit a local nursery for products such as 100% corn gluten meal (proven to naturally kill weeds and feedw the grass).




