As September quickly arrives, we hope everyone had a restful and enjoyable summer. **Pools will close Labor Day for the season**. I hope everyone had a chance to use the facilities this season—July seemed to disappear quickly with August right behind.

Tennis courts will **remain open through October** provided we do not have problems with people roller blading, using skateboards or playing baseball on the courts. Please remember that dogs are not allowed on the tennis courts.

Buildings are clean and ready to be rented for group meetings and "gettogethers". Please call Tom or Kathy Halter to make reservations. There is a deposit and building use form that must be signed before you will be permitted to use the buildings. The deposit will be returned to you upon inspection of cleanliness. Please follow all rules for building use posted at each facility. It is very important that everyone who have weekly rentals clean up and take their garbage with them. The buildings are used almost every day.

Fall also brings political campaigning. Please remember that it is against your covenants and restrictions to have signs on your lawn or common grounds in the Ransom Oaks community. This will be strictly enforced.

Lastly, fall is also the time when we experience vandalism, and break-ins at the facilities. Please call the police if you see anything suspicious going on in the community.

Board Meeting Highlights

August 8, 2016

- One resident attended the meeting.
- The property at 85 Moorgate
 Court is owned by the US
 Marshal's service and is in
 serious disrepair. The Marshal's
 service will not do any repairs.
 When the home is purchased
 the new owner will be
 responsible for bringing the
 home into compliance with our
 Architectural requirements
- Capital budget is about \$16,000 over the budget because of additional work we added after the budget was approved
- Lifeguard salaries are above budget because we hired an extra part time lifeguard and, because of the dry weather, we have many less pool closings because of rain.
- Certified letters were sent by the attorney to 24 property owners for unpaid 2016 assessments.
- About 150 residents attended the Community Party. Between 50 and 60 bikes participated. Thanks to the Swormville Fire Department for providing their fire truck.
- The Board of Directors will tour the Ransom Oaks facilities on August 16 to establish what improvements and repairs should be in the 2017 budget.
- After August 17 there will not be enough lifeguards available to support pool parties.
