During his tenure Ransom Oaks has experienced many changes. The community has grown by nearly 50 homes. Also, over \$500,000 of additions and improvements have been made. Major projects such as the acquisition and installation of the Glen Oak playground and the Eveningwood Pavilion were completed. The community rooms at Ransom Oaks and Greenwood have been remodeled. Overall, nearly 100 projects were undertaken while he was a board member.

His steady hand over all these years has been a tremendous asset to Ransom Oaks. We only hope we can continue without him as well as we have with him. All residents owe Mark a debt for his service. ### Ransom Oaks Board Meeting Highlights

January 9, 2017

- 10 residents signed in for the meeting. Others attended but did not sign in.
- A group of three residents sent a Certified letter questioning the budget. A board member offered to set up a separate meeting with them but they refused. An attempt was made to answer their questions.
- We ended 2016 \$17,000 over budget. Primarily because:
- A capitol expenditure planned for 2015 was not executed until 2016. The 2015 funds went into the reserve fund.
- Landscaping was \$6,000
   under
- Legal was \$10,000 under.
- We are preparing for the 2016 audit but the auditors want a substantial increase in their fees.
- The winners of the election were:
  - Jim Scott 107
  - Gene Zambarda 103
  - Anthony Ippoloito 16
- Votes were cast for 10 other names. However 7 of them either could not be identified as residents or were not eligible because they are already in the board.
- Florence Wagner of Old Oak Post won the drawing for a free 2017 assessment.
- With the departure of Mark Walsh, Pete Calinski will assume the role of president.
- Other assignments will be decided at the February meeting.


