





## Allan Davis hopes to enter Guiness Book with 11 Day Power Play

Ransom Oaks resident, Allan Davis, is hoping to become one of the latest members of the Guinness

Book of World Records. Allan, along with 39 other players, skated in The 11 Day Power Play, skating over 250 continuous hours at Harbour Center from June 22nd, to July 3rd. He had begun skating at the age of 5, joining the Squirts Hockey League in Nova Scotia, Canada, at age 7.

The 11 Day Power Play had been brewing in the mind of Mike Lesakowski. Mike's wife, Amy, is a breast cancer survivor and Mike's Mother, Evelyn, lost her battle to cancer in 2016. After the passing of Mike's mother, Lesakowski decided it was time to do something since cancer had affected his close family members. Lesakowski began recruiting players who had a passion for hockey, loved Buffalo and wanted to help find a cure.

All 40 players lived, slept, ate, and skated at Harbour Center for 11 straight days. Each team had 20 players, including 2 goalies. Players would skate for 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours, rest for 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  hours, and then hit the ice for another 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour skate. Occasionally player had shifts with only a 4 hour turn around before their next 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour skate.



The overall goal - to raise 1 MILLION dollars - for cancer research at Roswell Park Cancer Institute. Opening night, June 22nd, Mike and Amy were proud to announce they had reached their goal of \$1 Million dollars. Currently the monies raised are over \$1.2 million dollars with donations still being accepted. Each player was tasked with a personal fund raising goal of \$10,000 plus securing a Jersey sponsor of \$5,000. Allan's sponsor, Window World, stepped up to the plate. To date TEAM Davis has received over \$22,000 in donations.

Fellow Ransom Oak neighbors donated money and visited during Allan's skating shifts. Personal friend and neighbor, Lori Hogg, created a card campaign to help Davis stay motivated. Cards were delivered daily to a shoe box placed by the front

door at the Davis house. Tammy, Allan's wife, would then sneak the cards to Allan's bed for him to read.

Guinness will take about 6 weeks to verify all tapes and statistics before declaring The 11 Day Power Play as a record breaking event. For more information or to make a donation, visit www.11daypowerplay.com.
