Letter from the President

Following the board meeting on August 14th, the new members of the board met in an executive session. The board used that time to assign each member a primary role. Since that meeting the board has been hard at work continuing to complete the transition to LMM as the new management company. The board members are starting developing short, medium and long term plans to address issues related to their assigned role. We will be reaching out to the community shortly to request members to join committees.

Facilities: The pools remained open throughout the transition to the new management company. As happens every year, our college-age lifeguards have to leave before labor-day and that effects the opening times of the pools during the last two weeks of the season. The winterizing of the pools is scheduled after the labor-day weekend.

Communications: The communications group has been hard at work to get all our members setup on ROCC web site. Plans are being developed to further leverage our web site into a more effective tool for communicating with our members.

Playgrounds and recreational facilities: I spent an entire afternoon this past weekend taking a close look and photographing our facilities. The information I collected will provide a baseline. We will continue to work throughout the fall to fix high priority issues. We can't fix all the problems immediately, but during the winter we will be working with community members to develop medium and long range plans.
