President's Update

The board meeting on February 12th was well attended. Internet service is being installed shortly at the Greenwood facility. Once we have Internet service, we will be live-stream the meetings to Facebook. We hope that those members interested in the meetings, but that can't make it will appreciate the ability to watch the event at a later date.



ROCC has a centralized contact phone number: (716) 508-ROCC. When you call, please leave a message. You can use the phone number for any questions. Your question will be passed along to the appropriate board member or to the management company.

The new management company MCGK is now fully on-board and has been working incredibly hard. There is a lot of additional work that needs to be completed, due to lack of performance from the previous management company.

The new management company was selected using the following process:

- The board created an RFP based on the work requirements
- The RFP was sent out to interested parties
- Four interested parties reviewed the RFP, but onto two chose to complete the process
- A finalist was selected on the basis of the RFP response
- A final interview was held between the entire board and the finalist candidate
- The final contract was negotiated. Two key items added were "a pay for performance component" and a 60 day cancellation clause for either party.
- The presentation that was made at the January meeting, the RFP, and the RFP responses can be found on the ROCC web site.

The RansomOaks.com web site has been updated with meeting minutes and the management company selection process document and timeline presentation made at the January board meeting.

Open board seat and upcoming election: The ROCC board rules don't preclude someone from both being on the board and having a paid position for the organization. None the less, the board members and Michelle Winters all agreed that this could be seen as a conflict of interest, therefore Michelle stepped down from the board. The board position that was held by Michelle Winters is now open and we need to fill it quickly. There are also elections in April with three seats up for election. We have one member choosing not to run, due to personal time limitations. Anyone interested in the open position or running for office should send keep the following in mind. This is a volunteer position that will require dedication of time and effort. Please note that the current board members are putting in between 3 to 8 hours of work each week related to ROCC. If you are interested in either the open position or running for election please provide the following information:

- Provide a bio that includes: name, education, work background, and a short paragraph explaining why you are passionate to join the board and what you hope to achieve. Please provide the information in MS Word format so it can be published easily.
- Information on all candidates will be published as part of the election paperwork.
- Please email the information to any board member.

We continue to look forward to working with community members, to continue make Ransom Oaks a great place to live.
